## Ireland via UK landbridge to EU checklist

From January 1, 2021, the UK will effectively become what is known as in customs terms, a 'third country'. As a result, any goods moving from Ireland to the EU via the UK land bridge and vice versa will then require a Transit Declaration.

To submit a Transit Declaration, companies need a comprehensive customs guarantee along with customs-adapted software. These can be difficult and expensive to obtain and maintain. 
