


Ireland via UK landbridge to EU checklist

In January 2021, the UK became what is known as in customs terms, a 'third country'. As a result, any goods moving from Ireland to the EU via the UK land bridge and vice versa require a Transit Declaration.




Below are a list of the services provided by SGS and through TransitNet to assist our clients post Brexit.




- * Responsibility of the transporter, can be done manually by SGS if necessary
